**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING CITY’S
ADMINISTRATIVE MOTION TO EXTEND
TIME AND PAGE LIMIT FOR FILING OF
EVIDENTIARY OBJECTIONS TO
DECLARATION OF ROBERT PINOLI IN
SUPPORT OF OPPOSITION TO MOTION
TO REMAND, AND ACCOMPANYING
DECLARATION OF KRISTA MACNEVIN
JEE IN SUPPORT THEREOF**

On December 28, 2022, Plaintiff City of Fort Bragg filed its Administrative Motion to Extend Time and Page Limit for Filing of Evidentiary Objections to Declaration of Robert Pinoli in Support of Opposition to Motion to Remand, and accompanying Declaration of Krista MacNevin Jee in Support Thereof in the above-captioned matter, seeking:

An extension of time and page limit for the filing of the City’s Evidentiary Objections and Declaration of Krista MacNevin Jee in support thereof [DOC. 20], or in the alternative, an extension of time for the filing of evidentiary objections, within the page limits of the Reply, and an extension of time for the filing of the declaration in support thereof; and providing for the filing of any objection by Defendant Mendocino Railway within seven (7) days thereafter.

1 The court, having considered the City’s Administrative Motion and supporting
2 documentation, and any other pleadings in relation thereto, and/or the file in this matter, and finding
3 good cause therefor, hereby GRANTS the Motion and ORDERS as follows:

- 4 1. Plaintiff City of Fort Bragg is permitted an extension of time and of the page limit for the
5 separate filing of the City’s Evidentiary Objections [DOC. 20] to the Declaration of
6 Robert Pinoli [DOC. 17] in support of Defendant Mendocino Railway’s Consolidated
7 Opposition [DOC. 16] to Plaintiffs’ Motions to Remand, and is permitted an extension of
8 time for the filing of the Declaration of Krista MacNevin Jee in support thereof [DOC.
9 20-1]; and
- 10 2. Defendant Mendocino Railway may file any objection to the above within seven (7) days
11 thereafter, as provided in Local Rule 7-3 (d)(1).
