ESTIMATED OVERSIGHT COSTS – FISCAL YEAR 2022/2023, CALIFORNIA WESTERN RAILROAD (SKUNK TRAIN), 100 W LAUREL STREET, FORT BRAGG, CALIFORNIA (SITE CODE 520041)

Dear Mr. Buck:

Section 25269.5 of the California Health and Safety Code requires the Department of Toxic Substances Control to provide you with a cost estimate and schedule for oversight of the work at the California Western Railroad site located at 100 W Laurel Street, Fort Bragg, California. Enclosed is a schedule and estimate of DTSC's hours and costs to oversee the work identified through the end of the fiscal year. The estimate projects hours to be incurred (by staff classification) for planned oversight activities and identifies the estimated personnel labor rates. The schedule and cost estimate will be updated if necessary, because of changing circumstances. The cost estimate is for the fiscal year 2022/2023 which began on July 1, 2022 and will end June 30, 2023. The cost for fiscal year 2022/2023 has been estimated using classification rates from fiscal year 2021/2022. Classification rates for fiscal year 2022/2023 will be updated at a later date.

Please note that this is only an estimate of projected costs. You remain liable for all costs incurred by DTSC pursuant to the provisions of Health and Safety Code §25360 et seq., and the Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) 42 U.S.C §9601 et seq.
